1. Count all rooms that are at or below grade (ground level) _____
Don't forget to count offices, teachers lounge and restrooms.
2. For large open areas (auditoriums, libraries, gyms) use one _____
radon detector per 2000 sq. ft (minimum 1 per room)
3. Count all rooms that are on the floor above the ground floor _____
and multiply that number by 20% and enter the number here
4. Sub-total (add lines 1, 2 and 3 together) _____
5. Add in QC detectors (Multiply line 4 by 15%) _____
6. If line 4 is over 100, multiply line 4 by 5% for spikes _____
7. Total radon detectors needed to test your school _____
(add lines 4, 5 and 6)
